
THE VISUAL TEST (FROM 1938)



The drawing which you have just seen illustrates the scene of a smash-and-grab raid on a shop named Selfridge. Study this scene for one and a half minutes, taking in as much detail as you can. No notes! Then cover the image and address the questions. For these, you have five minutes.

- i) The locality, date and time the raid occurred.
- **ii)** By whom were the ground-floor premises adjoining Selfridge occupied?
- iii) Was there a business motor van in the vicinity at the time of the raid? If so, in what road was it standing and to what firm did it belong?
- **iv)** Was there a dance taking place on the evening on which the raid took place? If so, where was it being held?
- v) A car was being driven up Elm Road at the time of the raid. What was the registration number of the car, and how many people were in it?
