B from pair 4.

C from pair 2.

ON YOUR BIKE

Bike 1 appears in 13 rectangles.

Bike 2 appears in 10 rectangles.

Bike 1: ABCDEF, ABCDEFGHI, ACD, ACDG, CD, CDE, CDEF, CDEGH, CDEFGHI, CDG, D, DE, DEF.

Bike 2: ABCDEFGHI, BEFHI, CDEFGHI, CDEGH, EFHI, EH, GH, GHI, H, HI.

SAFE NUMBER

5 2 7 4 1 6 3.

For the penultimate number to be twice the value of the final number the options are: 2 and 1, 4 and 2, 6 and 3. In the first option the difference between numbers is not greater than one. In option two, it is no longer possible to create the code sequence without odd digits being next to each other. 6 and 3 must be the two final digits. The fifth digit has to be an odd one. 5 and 7 do not give a difference greater than one. Therefore the fifth digit has to be a 1. The fourth digit must be even, and as the difference between adjacent digits is always greater than one, it cannot be a 2. It has to be 4. The number in front of it must be odd and greater than one. Therefore it has to be 7. And so, 2 goes before 7, and 5 must be the first digit.

CHEERS!

Take the glass fourth from the left. Pour the contents into the empty glass on the far left, making sure not to touch the glass that is being filled. Replace your glass to the position fourth from the left. That's it. Job done!
