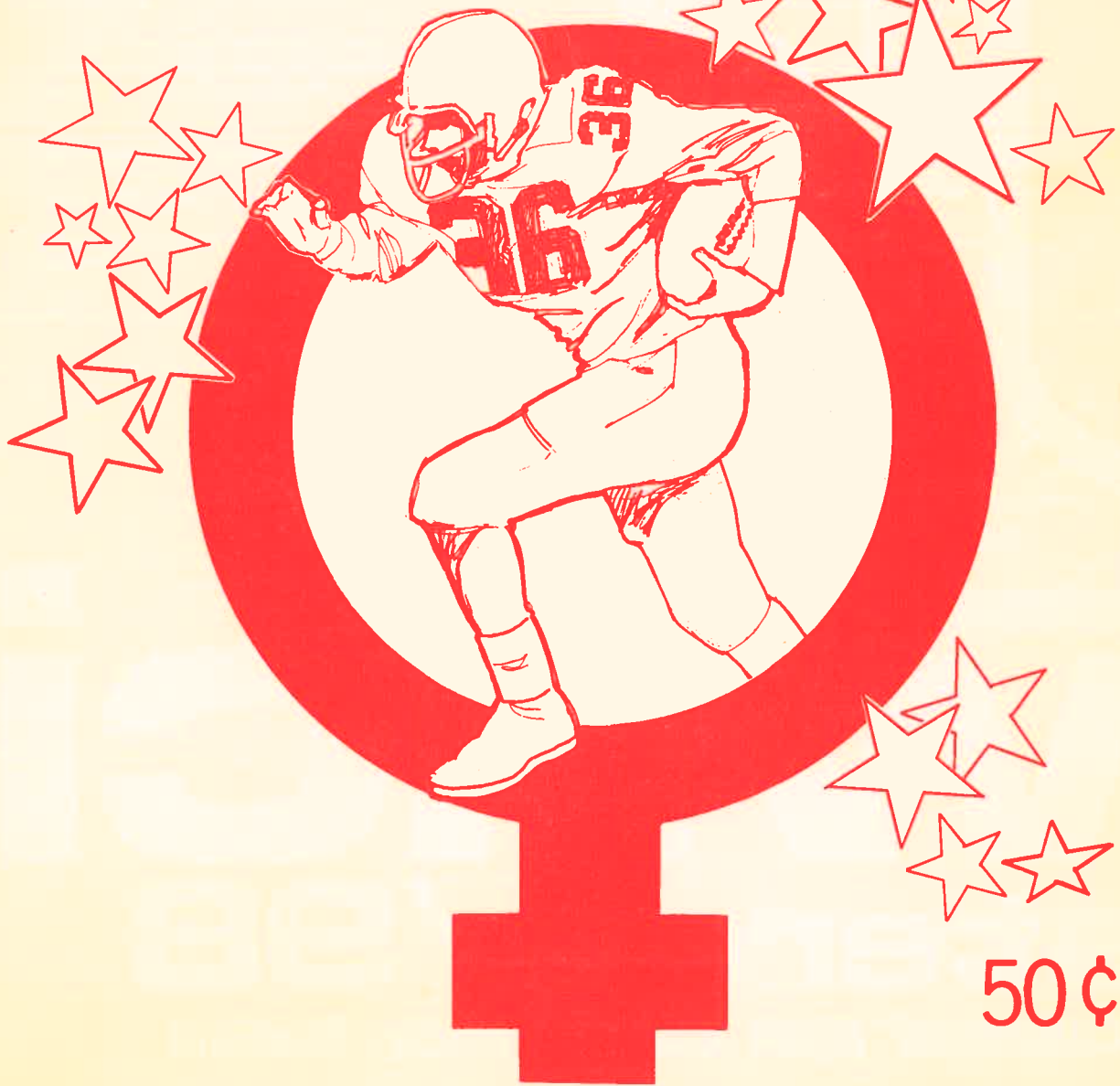

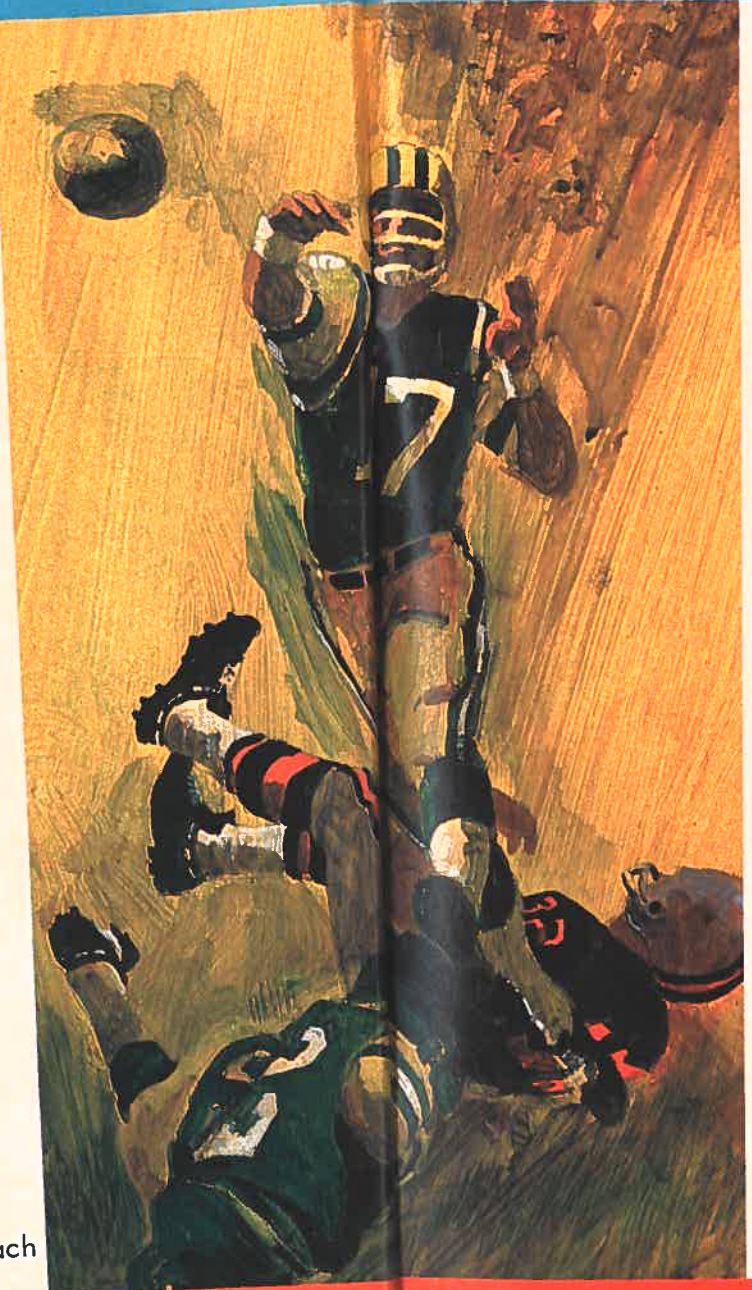

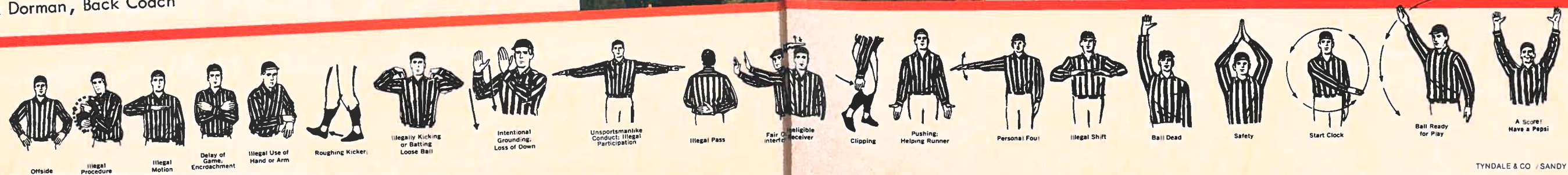

COLUMBUS PACESETTERS PLAYERS

PARALEE ADAMS is a third year defensive back who was selected as 1974's Most Valuable Player and 1975's Outstanding Defensive Back. She attended Bluefield State Univ., West Va. and presently halls from Columbus' near west side. Ms. Adams is the spouse of Carl Adams Sr. and the mother of Carl, Jr. and Terry. This is Paralee's third year as a team captain. **CHARLOTTE "TOT" ASH** is a rookie split end who is originally from Wooster, OH. She is a graduate of OSU in Respiratory Technology and is currently a Respiratory Therapist at Children's Hospital. **MAURA BAKER**, VETERAN guard, attended Bishop Ready High School. She is employed by Ohio Bell and is in her second season with the Pacesetters. **RENÉE BEAN**, originally from Mass., she attended the Univ. of Mass. and OSU.
