in half, and pull loop end through the CO row using a crochet hook. Thread the cut ends through the loop end and pull tightly. Rep across CO edge in alternating colors. Rep with BO edge.

- MC; knit on RS, purl on WS
- MC; purl on RS, knit on WS
- CC; knit on RS, purl on WS
- CC; purl on RS, knit on WS
