SHAPE TOP

(Change to dpns when necessary.)

Rnd 1: Working in St st, *P2, k2tog, k7, p2, k6; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: *P2, k8, p2, k6; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: *P2, k6, k2tog, p2, k6; rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: *P2, k7, p2, c6b; rep from * to end.

Cont as est, working 1 less st before/after decs and maintaining cable every 4th rnd to 72 sts, ending with a rnd 4.

Next rnd: *P2tog, k2tog, p2tog, k6; rep from * to end.

Next rnd: *K1, p2, k6; rep from * to end.

Next rnd: *P2tog, p1, c6b; rep from * to end.

Next rnd: *K2tog; rep from * to end.

Next rnd: *K2tog; rep from * to end.

Next rnd: *K2tog; rep from * to end—6 sts.

Break yarn, leaving a 6" tail. Draw tail through rem sts, pull to inside, and secure.

BRIM

With longer, smaller circular needle, pu 7 sts before and 7 sts after hat CO join.

P 1 row.

Next row: K2, m1, pm, k10, pm, m1, k2. Pu 2 sts from hat CO edge.

Next row: P to end, pu 2 sts from hat CO edge.

Next row: K to marker, m1, sm, k10, sm, m1, k to end, pu 2 sts from hat CO edge.

Next row: P to end, pu 2 sts from hat CO edge.

Rep last 2 rows until brim measures 2" (measured from center), ending with RS facing.

Turning ridge (RS): P 1 row.
