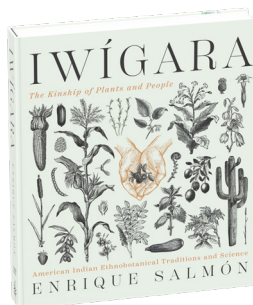
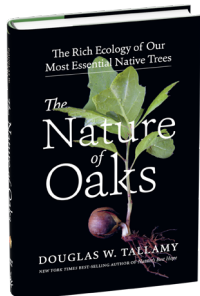
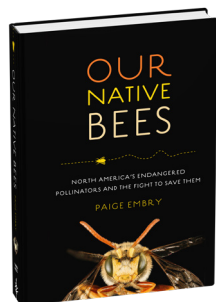
Lakes

Their Birth, Life, and Death

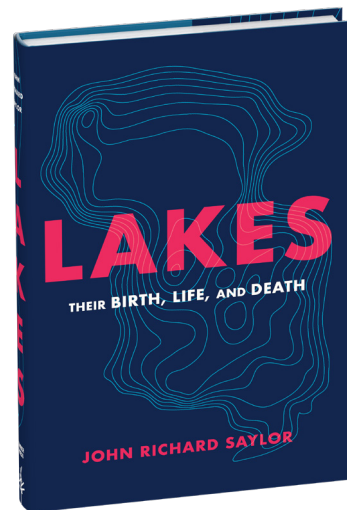
John Richard Saylor

In *Lakes*, John Richard Saylor explores a very common body of water that is of great ecological importance, revealing that there is much more beyond the surface. Readers will learn that even the most ordinary of lakes experience a scientific drama not unlike the emotional drama of their human counterparts. In spite of the calm pastoral nature that we see in the small duck pond down the street or the larger lake with the sailboat gliding across it in the distance, these everyday lakes experience an array of profound and wondrous processes, often hidden in plain sight.

Lakes begins with how lakes are born and what defines them. Saylor then explores the physical properties of lakes and the plant and animal life they support. Finally, he shows us the ways in which lakes die, either through human impacts or natural processes. As we look toward a future in which fresh water may become scarce, it is more important than ever to understand how lakes function and how to keep them alive and thriving.



John Richard Saylor, PhD, is a professor of mechanical engineering at Clemson University. He has spent the better part of his career studying fluid mechanics, specifically researching phenomena that occur at the interface between air and water. He lives in Clemson, South Carolina.

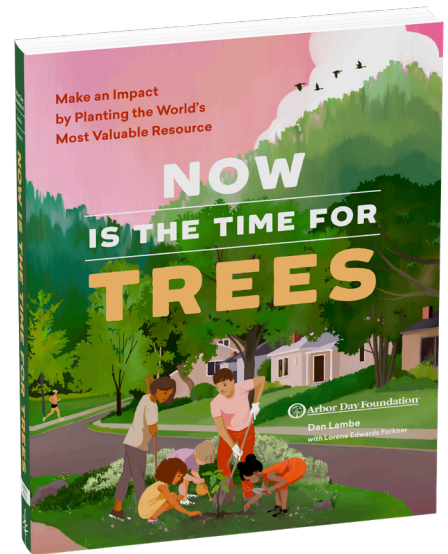

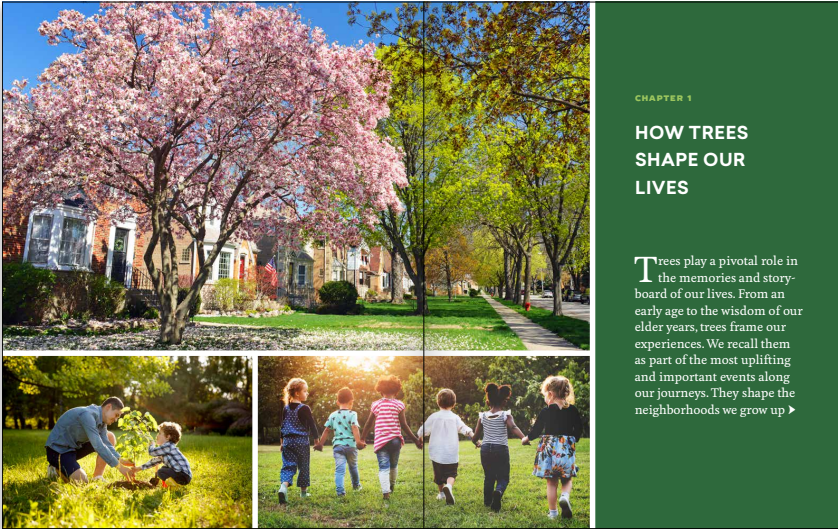

HOW TREES SHAPE OUR LIVES

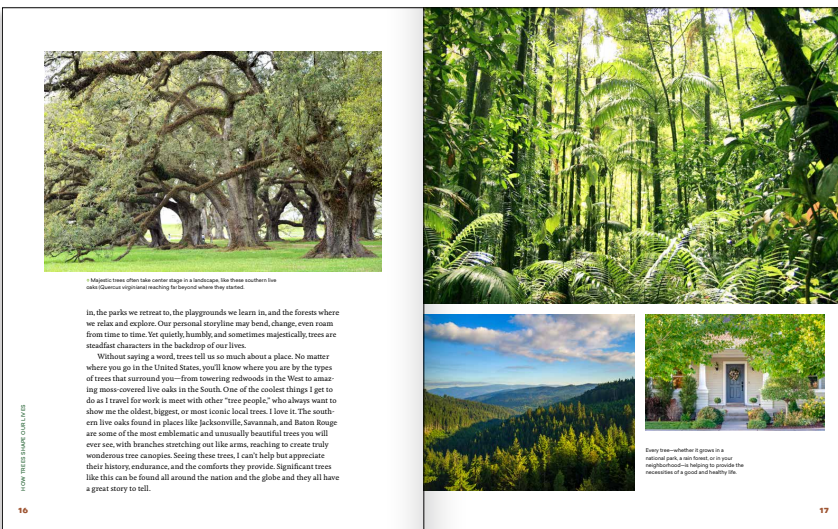

Lemon and Peach



"I don't like yellow."

Yellow is a love/hate colour—people are very clear about their feelings on yellow, more so than any other colour. It's an splitting colour, the colour of sunlight and gold and newborn chicks, yet the thought of a vivid yellow flower fills some people with horror. Move along to a pale greenish yellow—which is essentially lemon—and suddenly that person is happy again.

Yellow is highly visible, and perhaps this is why people are moved to feel so strongly. Once it is literally "smashed down" to lemon, it is much more acceptable. Lining on the side of cream makes it even more appealing, and that's what is happening here with several *Eschscholzia californica* 'Ivory Castle'. The pale lemon on large petals catches the light and holds on to it, somehow the brighter yellow centers seem increased in comparison. The creaminess of this palette needs only a gentle contrast: the Green 'Compassion' in the pale peach, its orange-yellow flowers appearing a light yellowish pink, just right against the California poppy.

This Green 'Compassion' is in the Cocktail Series, which includes greens with flowers in colours almost as drinkable as their names suggest: 'Mauve' and 'Banana Diploid' are also good as small highlights of lemon, pink, and apricot against larger blooms of any of these colours.

Here, the larger flower in the background provides bolder colour higher up—'Ivy Pink Charm' repeats the pink-yellow in the simplest of colour arrangements: a low band of peach, a middle section of lemon, and then the peach re-introduced.

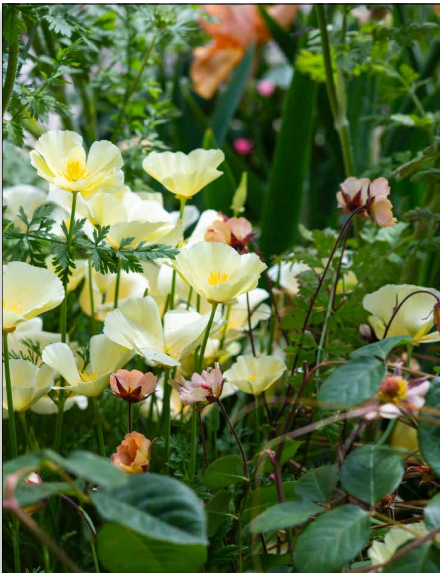
To create more variety here, one could take the cue from the dark purple color of the green and introduce another tall-headed one: 'Ivy Burgundy Party' replaces the shade of the green almost perfectly and would add interest. Alternatively, the addition of copper knock-downs would bring fibrous structure while still chiming with the simple tones of this planting.
