

- maintaining the seed stitch border on the eight stitches on both sides of the bag.
- * When you have completed the chart, continue working Rows 1 and 2 until the piece measures 15" (38 cm) from the tip of the flap. (Note: The center portion now has only 15 stitches.)
- * Bind off loosely in pattern.

Finishing

* Fold the front up, WS together, so that the top edge is even with the end of the flap. (When you fold the flap down over the front, the tip should just touch the top berry.)

Silk Berry Gewelry Bag

- knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows
- purl on RS rows, knit on WS rows
- slip 1 stitch to cable needle and hold in back, K1, K1 from cable needle
- slip 1 stitch to cable needle and hold in front, K1, K1 from cable needle
 - 5 knit into front, back, front, back, and front of stitch, turn and P5, turn and K5, turn and P2tog, P1, P2tog, turn and slip 1, K2tog, psso.
 - ▶ P2tog
 - no stitch
- Slip 1 stitch to cable needle and hold in back, K1, P1 from cable needle.
- slip 1 stitch to cable needle and hold in front, P1, K1 from cable needle.
