Seed Order Worksheet

We recommend making a seed order spreadsheet for each gardening year and updating it in the fall for the upcoming season. (Don't copy over old records; it is great to be able to look back at past years to see the quantities and types of seeds you ordered.) It is also possible to include perennial plants and seeds in your seed–ordering spreadsheet. Some perennials can be grown from seed, but many are purchased as plants, roots, or bulbs. Some of these can be easily ordered from seed vendors or other online retailers. Use the blank rows to insert additional annual and perennial crops you purchase that are not included here.
