STYLIZED DANCERS

The stylized dancers mobile is the final mobile in the Montessori visual mobile series. Like the other mobiles, it holds the baby's attention for a long time. It is made of stylized paper in gold or silver and a contrasting primary color cut in the shape of a person. The way the shapes move makes them seem like dancers (hence the name).

MATERIALS

- 1 sheet each of contrasting colored (blue and silver) metallic, holographic paper
- Silk thread
- Needle
- · Tracing pattern

 Three wooden dowels, 5 to 7 mm in diameter (ideally black or white, but plain wood is okay), cut to the following lengths:

Dowel A - 14 inches (35 cm)


Dowel B - 8 inches (20 cm)

Dowel C - 8 inches (20 cm)

Glue

CONSTRUCTION

- 1. Glue two pieces of holographic paper together. If paper is holographic on one side only, glue the blank sides together.
- 2. Attach the templates to the paper with paper clips.
- **3.** Trace the pattern with a pencil, pressing deeply to indent lines on the metallic paper.
- 4. Remove the pattern and cut the shapes out.
- **5.** Separate the different dancers using the pattern template as a guide.
- 6. With a fine needle and thread, string the shapes together (A1, A2, A3), (B1, B2, B3), (C1, C2, C3), (D1, D2, D3).
- 7. Thread string through the tops of the heads (the pieces labeled 1) at four varying lengths.



- **8.** Tie each dancer to the dowels as shown in the illustration. Add a drop of glue to each knot so they don't come untied.
- **9.** Hang 12 to 14 inches (30 to 35 cm) from the child's eyes. It can be raised higher after two to three months.
