ABOUT THE BOOK



Scarlett and Rosie March are haunted by the memory of their beloved grandmother being attacked and killed by a Fenris. Scarlett fought to save her grandmother, and although she didn't succeed, she did save her younger sister. Left with the scars of a werewolf attack, Scarlett lives to hunt and kill every Fenris she can find. Her best friend, Silas,

partners with her and Rosie, and together they lay waste to many. When the vicious Fenris packs increase in their killings, the two sisters and Silas move to the city. There they hunt and discover the Fenris are looking for the next Potential, a young man ready to be transformed into one of them. Dangling the bait to lure the Potential to his doom, the Alpha Fenris kidnaps Rosie, but with wit and cunning, Rosie, Scarlett, and Silas escape the certain death that awaits them.

DISCUSSION POINTS

- 1. What happens to a man once he becomes a Fenris? How does he live? What causes him to transform from man to Fenris?
- 2. What is the significance of the different Fenris packs: Coin, Bell, Sparrow, and Arrow? How are the Fenris from different packs identified?
- 3. Why are Rosie and Scarlett so close to each other? How does their dependence on one another help them to survive? How does their dependence on one another hurt them individually?
- 4. What role does Silas play in the sisters' lives? How does his role change as the story progresses?
- 5. Why do Rosie and Scarlett keep their grandmother's room as a memorial to her? What causes the sisters to remove items from her room?

- 6. What prompts Rosie and Scarlett to move from their home to the city? How does the move affect their relationship with each other? And with Silas?
- 7. How do Rosie's and Scarlett's motivations to hunt differ? How does that bring about conflict in their relationship?
- 8. What personality traits do the sisters share? How do their similarities and differences make them such a dynamic team?
- 9. Scarlett refuses to feel pity for herself and her scarred body, but she imposes a sense of responsibility on herself because of it. What responsibility does she assume? How does it affect her life?
- 10. Why does Rosie feel so much guilt? How does Silas help her overcome her feelings of guilt? Does Scarlett's jealousy have anything to do with Rosie's guilt?
- 11. As the Fenris attacks become more frequent and the search for the Potential becomes more intense, how does Scarlett react? To whom does she turn seeking answers?
- 12. As Silas, Rosie, and Scarlett try to determine the reason a young man becomes a Fenris, what do they discover?
- 13. What do the Fenris hope to gain by kidnapping Rosie? How is their plan ruined?
- 14. What does Silas do to protect Rosie from the possible danger he could cause her? What does Rosie's reaction to the danger say about their relationship?
- 15. If Silas had been transformed into a Fenris, would Scarlett have really killed him? Why or why not?
