

Plant GARLANDS

Making special garlands for holidays, birthdays, new seasons, or other special occasions can be a creative way to celebrate and invite herbal beauty into your home.

MATERIALS

- Scissors
- String, twine, or yarn
- Needle
- Plant material, as desired (herbs, flowers, leaves, pinecones, dried citrus slices, cranberries, popcorn, and so on)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut the string to the desired length of the garland plus several inches. Tie a knot at one end.
2. Thread the opposite end of the string through the eye of the needle. Push the needle through the plant materials, drawing the string through them with care so they do not tear or break.
3. When you're finished adding your materials, remove the needle, knot the end of the string, and trim off any extra.
