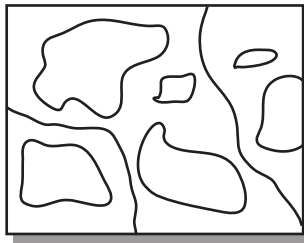




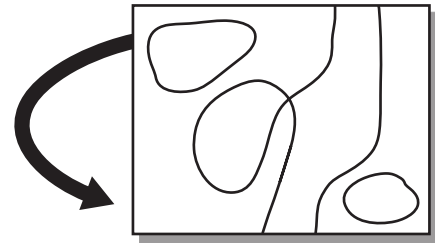

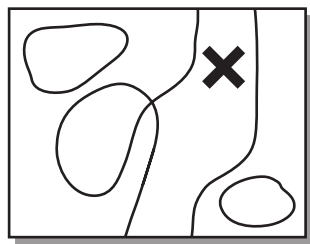
1. Find a suitable piece of paper for your map. It can be any color or size, but it must be ever so slightly see-through.



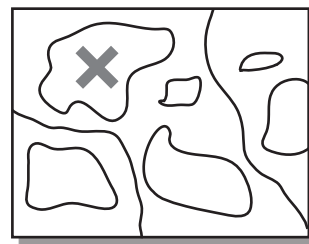
2. On one side, draw a map from your imagination. Make it somewhere delicious or somewhere awesome or somewhere gloomy.

4. This is the most important step. Put an 'X' somewhere on your map and make it dark enough to see from the other side.



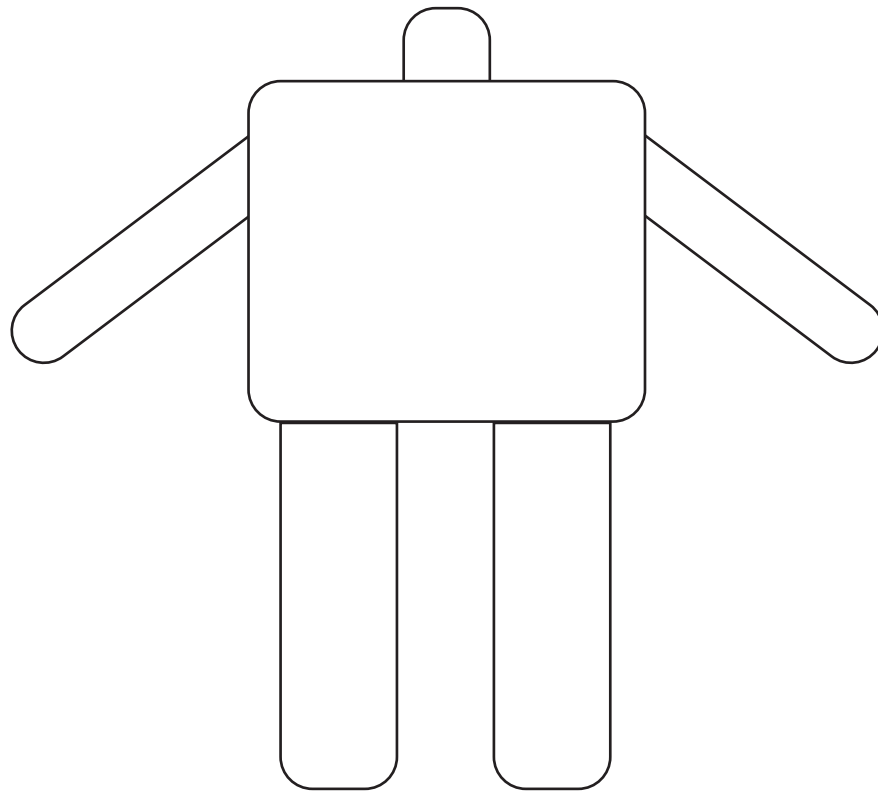
5. Test your map by traveling to the 'X' and looking for doors, cracks, and paths into your imagined world.

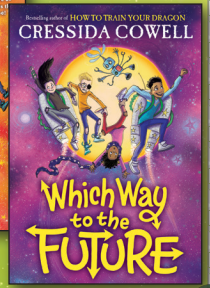
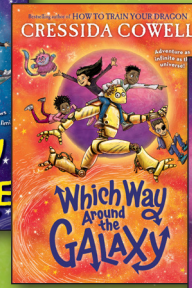
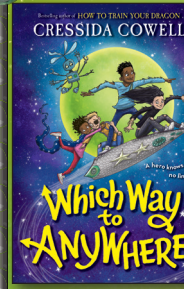


Once your robot is ready for action, try writing or telling a story about your robot's journeys around the galaxy!
