Harnessing the benefits of rewilding on a domestic scale

Despite being the subject of considerable (and I would argue largely unfounded) controversy, rewilding is, at its heart, simply about restoring natural ecological processes. The goal is habitat restoration and as a consequence of this, a reversal of biodiversity loss (Gleadow) and much more besides. There are plenty of well-matched studies that demonstrate these benefits in action. However, they are largely silent on how to apply the principles of rewilding to a more domestic context. And does it work on a more domestic scale? The Knappe Estate is our test case. Twenty years ago, Charlie Burrell and Isabella Tree, Charlie's daughter and her husband, began to try something new. They decided to rewild their 1,000-acre estate, which had been managed as a deer park for centuries. The results have been astonishing. Knappe now boasts breeding nightingales and turtle doves, as well as dormice, and is a listed as proof of nature's ability to recover, when given half a chance.

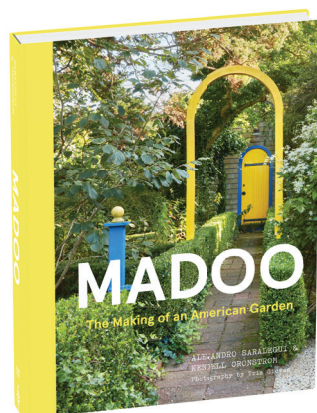
It's no surprise, then, that they have chosen the estate's wild garden as an experimental test bed for rewilding on a smaller scale. Once a compact lawn and series of immaculately tended ornamental beds, the garden has been redesigned with ecological complexity in mind. This is to create a complex mosaic of habitats (see Gleadow) for you would ever have seen of rewilded land but on a much smaller scale. This has been achieved through simple interventions such as creating three-dimensional hummocks and hollows of varying soil conditions, which support a greater diversity of plant species, and therefore insect and wildlife species. Over 200 species of plants have been introduced, and the garden, with its rich, rich, has already seen a 25-35% split in the number of invertebrate species recorded since baseline surveys.

Peppers

Ripening large, fleshy sweet peppers do best where summers are hot. It's tempting if you western British Columbia, but gardeners in cooler growing regions can grow sweet and other tender baby bell varieties, sweet-frying peppers, and many hot chilies.

GROWING You could grow your own peppers from seed but save to start indoors beginning in March so you'll have strong, sturdy plants to set out when the weather has warmed. However, when planting from seed, most of us don't chase pepper starts at the local nursery or farmers market. Not only does this allow for selecting an assortment of plants, but we can rely on the expertise of local growers who know what thrives under our growing conditions.

Before you plant peppers 20 to 40 centimeters apart in full sun and provide fertile soil and ample water throughout the growing season. Strongly resist the temptation to plant peppers outside before the weather warms up (nighttime temperatures should consistently remain above 12°C) because even a brief cold spell can permanently stunt plants and damage yield. With

a few heat-saving tricks, you can encourage these subsequent seasons to open earlier and produce larger crops. Try growing peppers in a hoop house or tunnel or season—provide protection to different other plants are in bloom—or selecting compact, ornamental varieties to grow in containers on a protected hot deck.

HARVESTING Baby bells and sweet frying peppers may be harvested green or allowed to mature in sweetens and color to yellow, orange, red, or purple. Hot peppers should ripen fully on the plant for the best heat. At the end of the season, pull entire plants and hang upside down in a protected garage or basement to finish ripening immature fruit.

VARIETIES Miniature Red Bell (55 days), Orange Savante (52 to 75 days), and Italian Sweet (75 days) are reliable sweet varieties. Only hot varieties include La Bomba II (50 days), a jalapeño type, Bully (75 days), and Trident (80 days), a robust poblanos.

Potatoes

Potatoes excel in BC gardens and are very productive even in a small space. Local producers offer a diversity of varieties, almost-free seed stock, providing home growers dozens of unique varieties beyond those available at the local grocery store. You can grow potatoes in a variety of shapes, sizes, colors, and harvest times.

GROWING Potatoes are deeply taprooted in full sun, well-aerated soil compared to further lightening. The soft and moist moisture-retentive potatoes prefer slightly acidic conditions as well as time where you have to plant. Plant seed potatoes (they should be planted whole or larger tubers cut into pieces) between March and May, ideally when soil temperatures range between 15 and 20°C. Tubers are subject to rot in wet soil before sprouting if they are planted too early, although "chitting" (see page 47) gives you a running start on the growing season.

Dig a shallow trench about 15 to 20 centimeters deep and place seed potatoes 20 to 30 centimeters apart at the bottom, cover with 8 to 10 centimeters of soil but do not completely fill the trench. Sprinkle arrange in a single of rows depending on soil temperature. When plants are about 20 to 25 centimeters tall, use a weed board or hoe to scrape soil from either side of the trench, burying the stems but leaving half of the new exposed plant is called hilling the crop. Hill again in two to three weeks, once more leaving half of the new larger plants exposed, repeat in another two weeks.

Keep plants evenly watered and mulch to keep soil cool and moist. During this period of active vine growth, fertilize plants with a mild liquid fertilizer like fish or kelp emulsion. Stop fertilizing once
