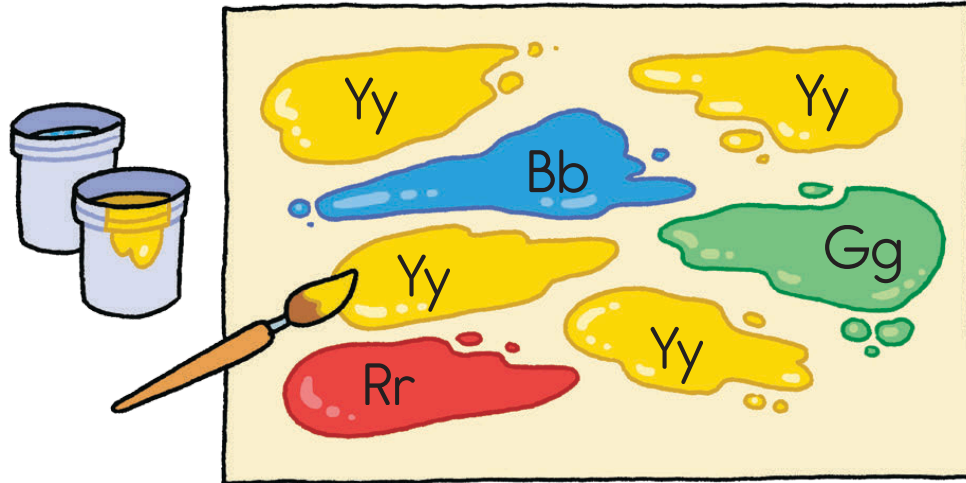
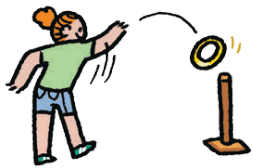

A dime is worth 10 cents or 10¢. Ten pennies make up one dime.



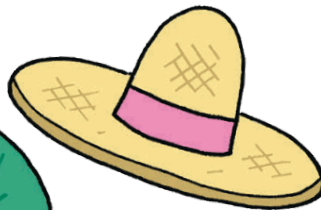
